

KCAA Archery

KCAA Member Schools having archery programs which follow the criteria of National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP) are eligible to compete annually in the KCAA State Archery Tournament. The tournament will be held in the Spring following the KY NASP State Tournament. Location for the tournament will alternate between KCAA Member Schools with archery programs and will be determined and agreed upon at the KCAA Spring/Summer Meeting.

KCAA Member Schools may choose to compete in one or more of the following three divisions, however may register only one team per division; Elementary (Grades 4-5), 'Junior Varsity' Middle School (Grades 6-8) and/or 'Varsity' High School (Grades 9-12).

KCAA Member Schools unable to compete in the KCAA NASP State Tournament as a 'team' may register their archers to compete as 'individuals'.

KCAA State Archery Tournament will follow all KY NASP State Tournament Rules with the EXCEPTION of the following;

1.1 – In School Requirement

Not required, although recommended for the ease of registration and scoring, *see note below

1.6 – Number of Archers per Team

KCAA Archery Teams must contain 6-24 archers, no gender requirement

1.8 – Small School

KCAA Archery Teams may NOT combine archers from different divisions to form a team

2.0 – State Tournament Registration Protocols

KCAA State Tournament will be posted on the NASP Tournament website (nasptournaments.org) by the host KCAA Member School no later than February 1. All KCAA Member Schools will register to participate in the tournament via the tournament listing on the website, *see note below

5.13 – Scoring Summation of Team Scores

KCAA Archery Teams will use a teams highest six (6) scores to comprise a team score

10.0 – Awards

*Championship (1st Place) and *Runner-Up (2nd Place) Trophies for Varsity (High School) and Junior Varsity (Middle School) Teams will be provided by the KCAA. All other awards will be provided by the host KCAA Member School and shall include the following;

Trophies (Teams)

Championship and Runner-Up Elementary

Medals (Teams/Individuals)

ALL Championship and Runner-Up Team Members and Coaches

1st thru 5th Girls/Boys in each division (Elementary, Middle School and High School)

Plaques (Individuals)

Overall Tournament Score Boy/Girl

KCAA Athletic Fees will apply to all KCAA Member Schools registering any archer to participate in either the Junior Varsity (Middle School) and/or Varsity (High School) Divisions.

Tournament Fees will apply and be decided by the host KCAA Member School.

*KCAA Member Schools not currently competing National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP) events due to not having met the annual in-school teaching requirement as set forth in Section 1.1 of the KY NASP Tournament Rules, may still participate in KCAA State Archery Tournament however they will have to register, compete and be scored separately from the other tournament participants/teams. All results will be combined at the conclusion of the tournament and participants/teams awarded accordingly.
